# ST. JAMES FORDHAM

St. James Terrace is under construction in the Bronx on land leased from St. James Fordham. The new property will offer 102 units, including 50% targeting homeless adults with mental illness.

Proceeds from the ground lease will fund renovations to the historic, 1864, stone church plus construction of a new community service center.

- approx \$350k invested for future maintenance, capital needs

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- We held brainstorming sessions, congregational meetings, focus groups, etc.

- About six major things occurred that allowed the ground lease money to fund the church building




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# What I've learned about faith during this discernment

- Compromise is required.






### How our faith has been deepened

- We are a stronger congregation and have the faith to finish what we have started


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




# Lesson 2: Use all the tools you know to discern your mission and build consensus about it.
